Pondering Together the Treasures of our Faith

As it is National Poetry Month, and April 27 is "Poem in your Pocket" Day, maybe a poem would do us good as we celebrate the Holy Season of Easter! The poem I have selected is "I dwell in Possibility" by Emily Dickinson.

I dwell in Possibility -
A fairer House than Prose -
More numerous of Windows -
Superior - for Doors -
Of Chambers as the Cedars -
Impregnable of eye -
And for an everlasting Roof
The Gambrels* of the Sky -
Of Visitors - the fairest -
For Occupation - This -
The spreading wide my narrow Hands
To gather Paradise -

(*a type of gable roof with two slopes on each side.)

The Irish ethicist and theologian, Oliver O'Donovan, suggests that the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is like a stone which God has thrown into the pool of history. From its central position, one can trace the ripples that spread out all around it.

The Resurrection of Jesus is everything. Saint Paul suggests that if Jesus has not been raised from the dead, our faith is meaningless. All things are possible because Jesus and his love for us were not extinguished by his death. Nothing can stop the Lord from loving us. Nothing is stronger than his love, not darkness or terror or hatred or violence or prejudice or sin. The risen Jesus has conquered all of these, and even death itself.

The key for you and me is to spread wide our hands and open our hearts in invitation to the Risen Lord. Invite him into your life and all things become possible. In the midst of hurt or illness, in the face of addiction or fear, overwhelmed by anxiety, grief, obsession or loneliness, the Risen Jesus, alive and well, comes into our lives. Now it is possible to experience peace and strength, to be able to cope and hope. Our struggles may still remain but there is now the possibility of accepting them as we trust more and more that the Risen Lord will always be with us.

A week ago, on Palm Sunday in Rome, Pope Francis invited young people to become people of the way of Jesus, and "to do so with joy, to do so with your aspirations, without fear, without embarrassment, to do so courageously. See beauty in small things, that everyday beauty: to see it, not to lose it. And to be thankful for what you are: I am like this; thank you! So often in life we waste time asking ourselves, But, who am I? But ask yourself, For whom am I? For whom, for which person am I? Do a job that makes you think, that makes you feel, and that makes you work. The three languages: the language of the mind, the language of the heart, and the language of the hands....But, Father, I have sinned, I fall so many times. There comes to mind a very beautiful Alpine song, which the Alpine troops sing: "In the art of climbing, what is important is not to not fall, but not to stay fallen." Go on! You fall? Get up and go on."

Just maybe this is what resurrection looks like in our ordinary, everyday lives. There is always the possibility for something good to come out of every situation. With the Risen Jesus on our side, all things are possible! Happy Easter!
