IN JOY & SORROW

Pondering Together the Treasures of Our Faith



Following the great Feast of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost, the Church leaves behind the Easter Season, fifty days long, and returns to Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time in 2017 spans twenty-five weeks and will conclude on Sunday, December 3, when the Holy Season of Advent begins.

This designation of Sundays as "ordinary" seems a bit odd. Does "ordinary" imply that these Sundays are somewhat less in significance than the Sundays in the Christmas or Easter Seasons? Are these Sundays somewhat mundane? Why ordinary when, in fact, the early Church Fathers and Mothers taught that every Sunday is an Easter Sunday, in which we celebrate the dying and rising and ascending of Jesus and His sending of the Holy Spirit? There is nothing mundane about this Paschal Mystery!

The United States Catholic Conference of Bishops explains Ordinary Time in this way:

Christmas Time and Easter Time highlight the central mysteries of the Paschal Mystery, namely, the incarnation, death on the cross, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus Christ, and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through the life of Christ Jesus. This is the time of conversion. This is living life with Christ.

Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ Jesus. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

The intent of Ordinary Time is for us, the People of God, to drill down more deeply into the life of Jesus, his teaching and his example. Ordinary Time begins with the Baptism of the Lord. The Second Sunday of Ordinary Time recounts Jesus' first miracle, which was the changing of water into wine at Cana of Galilee. So, you see, we are reconnecting ourselves to the ministry of Jesus, in the great hope that we might better imitate that ministry. We are to grow more deeply in our faith, that is, our friendship with Jesus. As green is the color of growth, the vestments of the priest and deacon are green during Ordinary Time.

Now, on what is a more mundane note, the Latin word *ordo* and the English word *order* are one and the same. This time during the year is ordered and we simply give numbers (which, in the Latin, are *ordinals*) to each of the Sundays. And that is why we call them the Ordinary Sundays of the Year.

Finally, in 2017, the Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time is Trinity Sunday (this weekend) and the Eleventh Sunday is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (next weekend). Therefore, you will not hear me welcome you to Ordinary Time until I announce on the weekend of June 24-25, "We celebrate the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time." You will not see the green vestments until then! And no, we do not wear green during the NFL Season to celebrate our Green Bay Packers! We wear green to remind ourselves that we need to be about growing deeper in our friendship with the Lord! Father Bill +

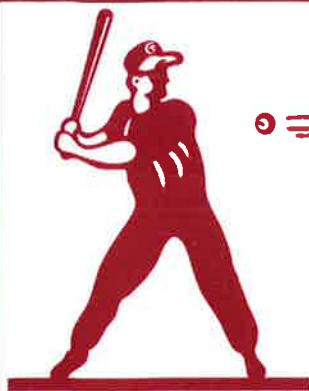

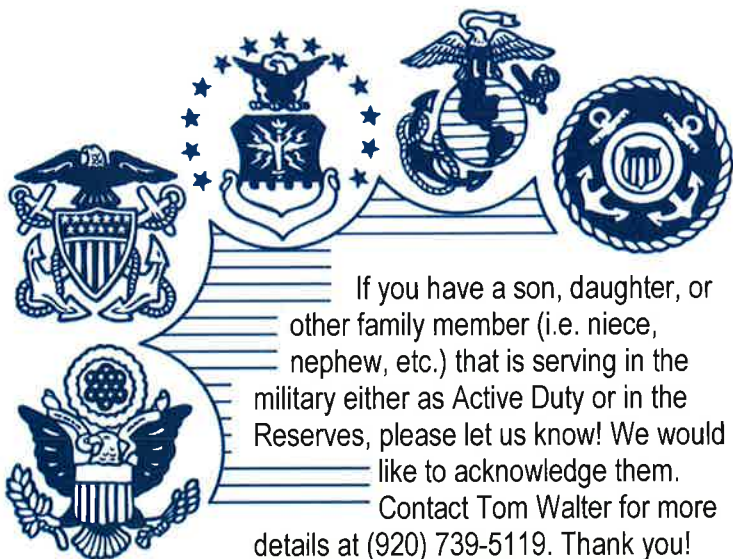
