IN JOY & SORROW

Pondering Together the Treasures of Our Faith

This weekend marks the third anniversary of my appointment as Pastor of Saint Mary Parish. These three years seem to have sped by for me, and I hope, for you. I feel more sure of myself today as I share leadership with the Pastoral Team and the Pastoral Council. I believe that the most effective leaders are good listeners who are humble and value the contributions of other parish leaders. I believe in the grace that comes with dialogue and collaboration, so my approach is never heavy-handed. My experience has taught me that there does come a time for a decision to be made by the Pastor, especially if the issue is a divisive one. Sometimes it is better to decide so that everyone can begin to move forward and so stanch the bitterness that comes with division. Division, in my mind, is never a good thing. It is the modus operandi of the devil, who is the Divider par excellence. I am happy to report that I sense that there are no divisions among us.

I have thoroughly enjoyed my ministry here at St. Mary Parish. You are a wonderful faith community with a grateful and generous spirit.

Over the past three years, on the Pastoral Team, we have said "Good Bye" to Joan Paalman, parish secretary, Nancy Woods, liturgist, and Carol Jensen, pastoral minister, each one of them very dedicated and committed servant leaders for many years. We have welcomed Betsy Pfantz, our Family Life Minister, and will announce soon who will pick up the baton and move us forward in Adult Faith Formation as Carol Jensen's successor. Brian Dresang (Administrator), Sr. Joanne, Deacon Gerry, Tom Walter (parish liturgist), Theresa Rohm (Bookkeeper), Betsy, and I are all kept on track by our capable new Parish Co-Administrative Assistants, Julie Morse and Annie Geurts. They are a delightful addition to our Team.

In the area of Religious Formation of your children and teenagers, we have said "Good Bye" to Andrew Russell, who directed the program so faithfully for twelve years. Soon you will be meeting Diane Cahill (Grades Kindergarten-4, First Eucharist/Reconciliation Preparation) who will join the collaborative team of Jenny Schubring (Grades 6-8, Reconciliation/First Eucharist), Peter Leitermann (Grades 9-11, Confirmation for Grade 12, and Youth Minister), Dana Schmidt (Office Manager) and Barb Miller (Bookkeeper). Of course, we share these generous ministers with Saint Joseph Parish.

I am excited every day to minister alongside these wonderful Parish Leaders.

This past year the Pastoral Leadership Council, under the chairmanship of Matt Boyle, labored hard to create new Mission and Vision Statements for our Parish. This process, directed by Nadine Duncan, a member of the Council, was truly a work of the Holy Spirit. There was much give-and-take throughout and I was reminded of the importance of using language that was not overly theological. Come this fall we will announce these new statements to the parish. I will take some time in this forum, In Joy and Sorrow, to break open and dig under these statements, embellishing them with the Scriptures and the theology that are very much grounded in the ministry of Pope Francis. This fall, too, the Pastoral Leadership Council we will begin to strategize as to how we are going to live these new Mission and Vision Statements. Your Parish Pastoral Leadership Council will be energized by this process. This is a new focus for us that moves us from a maintenance mode to a mission mode. It is time to move forward and to stretch ourselves as a parish community in some very new and challenging directions that remind each one of us of our baptismal responsibility to be missionary disciples of Jesus. We need to always be going outside of ourselves to touch others with the love and mercy of Jesus. We need to grow our parish and increase the number of people attending Mass on the weekend.
