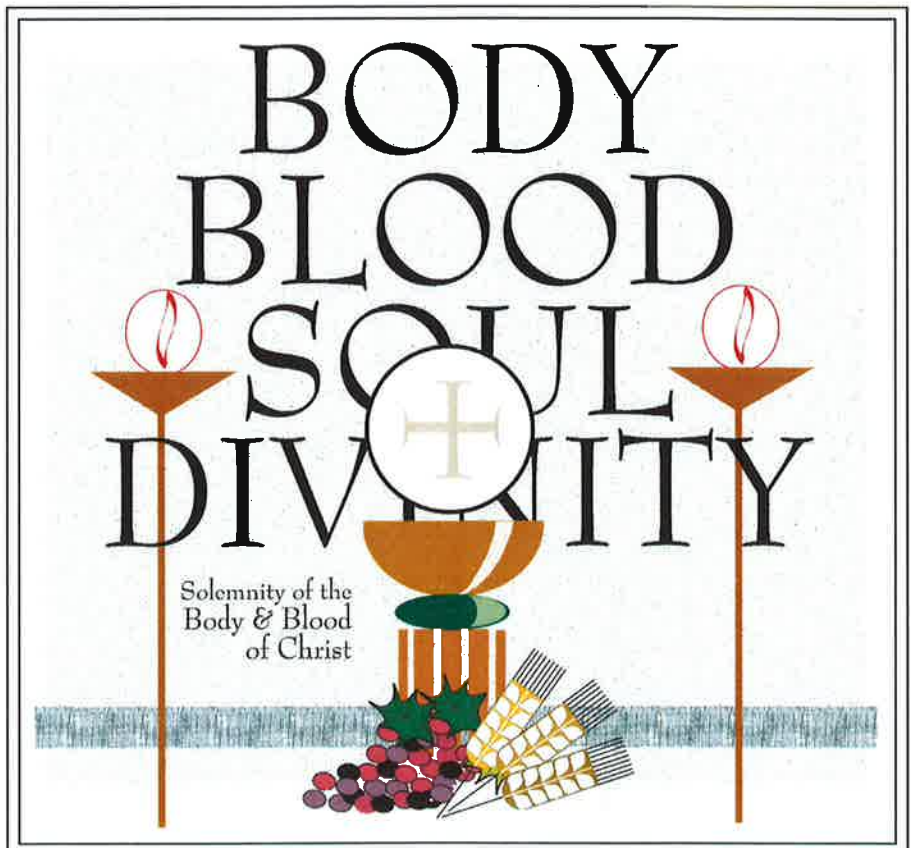

In Joy and Sorrow PONDERING TOGETHER THE TREASURES OF OUR FAITH

On Friday, June 3, the Church celebrates the Solemn Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Last Thursday (5/26) began an intense time of prayer for nine days in preparation for the Feast of Jesus' Sacred Heart. You need to know that the traditional day for the Solemn Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) is the second Thursday after the Feast of Pentecost, which was last Thursday. Beginning a novena on that day brings us to the Feast of the Sacred Heart, nine days later.

Again, the Church thought it wise to move the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus to the next Sunday, which is this weekend. Remember, the Church has done something just like this for the Feast of the Ascension of Jesus and the Epiphany of the Lord. What is the reason for this switch away from tradition? I believe it is because more of the People of God are present for a weekend celebration of the Mass than for a weekday celebration and so are present to worship on these important feasts of the Church.

Getting back to the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I recall that the motto of Blessed Cardinal John Newman of England, who was beatified by Pope Benedict in September of 2010, is cor ad cor loquitur, which is Latin for "heart speaks to heart." In his homily for the Beatification Mass, Pope Benedict said, "(This motto) gives us an insight into (Newman's) understanding of the Christian life as a call to holiness, experienced as the profound desire of the human heart to enter into an intimate communion with the Heart of God. He reminds us that faithfulness to prayer gradually transforms us into the divine likeness. As he wrote in one of his many fine sermons, "a habit of prayer, the practice of turning to God and the unseen world in every season, in every place, in every emergency - prayer, I say, has what may be called a natural effect in spiritualizing and elevating the soul. A person is no longer what he (she) was before; gradually... he (she) has imbibed a new set of ideas, and become imbued with fresh principles."

Jesus reveals His Heart to us whenever we draw close to Him in prayer. This prayer can never be so much about us. Sometimes we bend the Lord's ear too much; he already knows what is going on in our lives and in the lives of our loved ones. Our prayer invites us to lean close to Jesus so that His Heart can speak to our hearts. Prayer, immersed in stillness and silence, is most profound when we open our hearts to the Lord so that Jesus can pour from His heart into our hearts His peace and strength, His forgiveness and mercy, and His love and joy. Jesus is always standing at the door of the human heart, knocking gently. He will never try to break the door down, but waits patiently for us to open the door of our heart. The Heart of Jesus is still being pierced for love of us. Still from the Heart of Jesus flows the grace of Baptism conforming us to Jesus, and the grace of the Eucharist, the gift of His Precious Body and Blood, also conforming us to Jesus. All goodness flows outward forever from the Heart of Jesus.

Here is a Litany of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, composed by Father Austin Fleming, the Concord Pastor that might guide you to the Lord Jesus' Heart on these days in which we anticipate Friday's Feast.



Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! So loving, so humble, so gentle, so compassionate, so faithful, so wise, so patient, so steadfast, so tender, so spacious.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! God's joy, God's shalom, harp of the Trinity, wingbeat of the Spirit, breath of God, five-petaled rose.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Womb of justice, birthplace of peace, our dearest hope, longing of our lives.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Freely flowing fountain, spring of grace, freshest of forgiveness, merciful river, mystical dew.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Warmth of our hearts, transforming fire, cosmic furnace, enflamer of hearts.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Heart of evolution, beginning and ending, center of all.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Our refuge, our shelter, our comfort, our rest, our welcoming breast.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Wounded by love, pierced by our cruelty, broken by our hardness, mystic winepress, poured out as gift.

Heart of Jesus, hear our prayer! Have mercy, gracious heart, give us gratefulness, teach us tenderness, let us learn to love.
