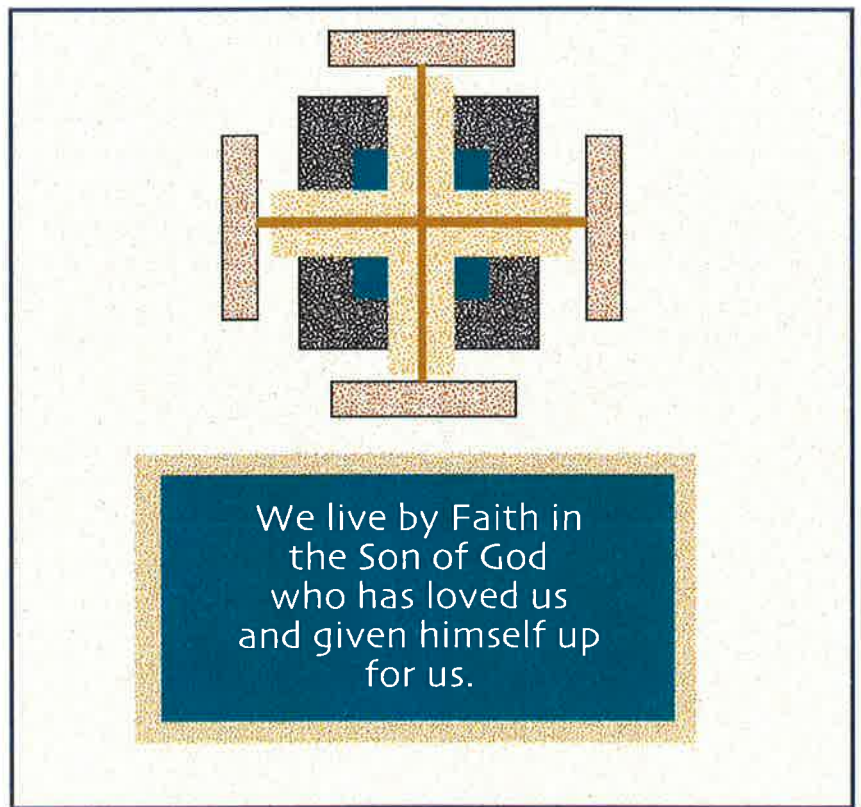

In Joy and Sorrow PONDERING TOGETHER THE TREASURES OF OUR FAITH

I thought that I would share with you the letter I wrote to our 2016 high school graduates of Saint Mary Parish. I have bracketed the first part because this was omitted from my final letter in the spirit of shortening my message. As you might have figured out, sometimes I can get a bit long-winded in my speech and my writing!

[At a 2016 Commencement Ceremony for Benedictine College in Acheson, Kansas, Cardinal Timothy Dolan of New York told this story:

Michelle, a beautiful twenty-four-year-old French woman, volunteering among refugees in Erbil, Kurdistan, in that violated and violent corner of Iraq, was teaching 500 children in a wonderful makeshift school run by Dominican Sisters. "What do you teach?" I (Card. Dolan) asked her. "Reading, spelling, history, science?"

"No, none of those," she replied. "I teach the children to pray. Every day I take them, class by class for about fifteen minutes, to our little chapel, in front of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. I read a bit of the Bible to them, and we're silent for awhile. Then I remind the children, who have their eyes closed, that God lives within them, that God knows them so well, that God loves them, that God hears them, that God is always with them, that God will never abandon them, and that God wants them to spend eternity with God. See, these children have lost moms and dads, homes and friends. They're so scared and alone. If I can just give them a sense of God's presence and love, that will help them even more than computer skills!"]

As you graduate from high school, know that I and your Saint Mary Parish Family are just as proud of you as your family and friends! I hope that you feel good about yourself and are just as proud of all that you have achieved. Never will you be able to go back and capture the experiences that you shared with your graduating class. Treasure those relationships and memories. Be grateful to the Lord for them!



Graduation, though, is called a commencement! May you be filled with confidence and peace of mind and heart as a new chapter in your life opens! Trust that it will be exciting and that all will be well.

I have included a prayer* composed by the great Trappist monk, Father Thomas Merton. In the spirit of Michelle, I would encourage you to not forget about the Lord as you live out this new chapter in your life. Trust in Jesus, turn to Jesus, treasure your friendship with Jesus, and traipse to Church to worship him on the weekend! ("Traipse" means to "walk or go somewhere." I wanted to keep the t's going... trust, turn, treasure, traipse...). Many, many years ago, I took this very prayer with me to the University of Wisconsin at Madison as a freshman and prayed it often!

Congratulations! If there is ever anything I can do for you, don't hesitate to give me a call! God Bless You and Hold You Close to the Lord Jesus' Heart!
