

Sunday Mass Time Changes

Over the last three years the Pastoral Council, Pastoral Staff, and Liturgy Committee have been discussing the possibility of going from three Masses to two Masses on Sunday morning. Many parishioners have asked when we were going to make the change. Recently, we received comments on our parishwide survey stating that parishioners felt that now was the time.

The Pastoral Council decided to take on this project. Fr. Bill and the staff were not actively involved so that the final recommendation of Mass times would come from the Pastoral Council as representatives of the parishioners. After discussion and focus groups with over 100 parishioners, and prayerful consideration as a council, we recommended to Fr. Bill that our two Sunday Mass times be at 8 and 9:45 AM. Fr. Bill has agreed and these Mass times will begin on Sunday, May 27, 2018.

We know these Mass times will affect those of you who worship at our 11 AM Mass the most, and would like suggestions on how we can make this transition as smooth as possible for you. Also, we would like to thank all the parishioners who participated in this process. The discussions were healthy, challenging, and showed that in the end, we are committed to making the sometimes hard but necessary changes that will lead to the health and growth of our parish family.

I feel very blessed! What a lovely gift that my first column is during the Easter Season. It is a time when the GREATEST STORY ever told continues to unfold in scripture and hopefully in our hearts.The disciples are meeting the Risen Lord and we can feel their excitement. Their surprise and amazement prepares us for our own personal encounters with Jesus. Our moments become important chapters in our own Jesus Story.

My latest chapter of meeting the Risen Jesus happened a week ago. Let me tell you this story: My husband and I are part of an Ecumenical Prison Ministry. About four times a year we go to the Oshkosh Correctional Facility on a Sunday evening and provide two worship services for about 250 inmates. It is always a moving experience from the reality of the tight security getting in and out of the facility to standing in line shaking hands with the inmates as they enter and also leave the service. Some are so young and some are so old. They could be our grandfathers, fathers, brothers, sons and grandsons.

It is especially difficult for new volunteers not to be saddened by the state of the inmates lives even though they know they are paying for their crimes.

Those who believe see the face of Jesus when we look in their eyes.

The prison has an amazing worship band and choir made up of inmates. It is multicultural and the energy in the room when they are leading worship is unmistaken. The depth of the songs in the context of the setting brings people to their feet and in my case, tears to my eyes.

One of the songs we sang together was Praise You in This Storm by Casting Crowns (please watch it on YouTube). It is a song about the hope that God would reach down and save us during the storms in our lives. Though there is a longing to hear God's voice during this time, there is faith that God never leaves us and that he holds each of our tears in his hand. The song helps us to make a conscious choice to praise God in our darkest moments.

Powerful message. Powerful delivery.

Last Sunday in a storm-filled place, I remembered the thunder of my own life and I had an incredible encounter with the love and mercy of the Risen Jesus. I was surprised and blessed!

You have Jesus stories, too. Remember them. Share them. Spread the Good News!
