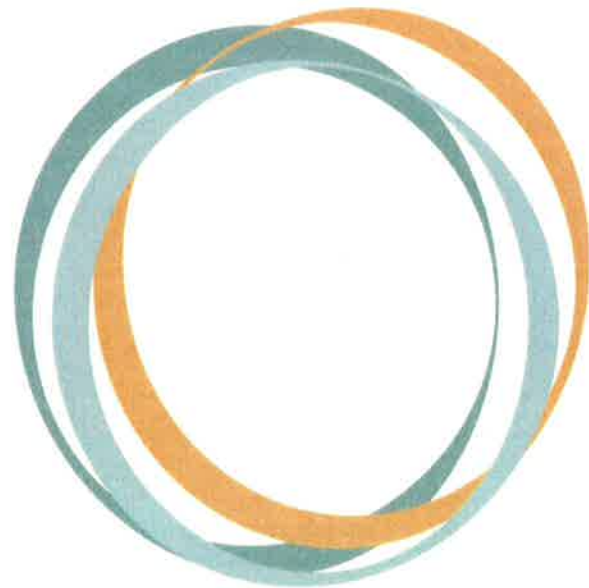

A VIEW FROM THE SHORT SIDE...

When Fr. Bill told me I needed a title for my column, I immediately sent both of my parents an email, asking them to put their thinking caps on. Between the three of us, I knew we could come up with something. Many possible titles were thrown around, and I'll give credit to my dad for coming up with my personal favorite: "The Inspirational Writings of a Snot-Nosed Kid." My mom doesn't like the word "snot," though, so that title was quickly shot down.

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, I cannot help but think that each one of us is called into community with our family, our friends, people we go to school with or work with, and the people we go to church with. I have a community with my parents, a community with my co-workers, a community with my friends, and I am reminded today that these communities are always a reflection of the Holy Trinity. In these communities we share love, friendship, joy, and sorrow - the same things which are shared in the Holy Trinity. We can never be exactly like the Most Holy Trinity, but we create divine communities all the time with the people we interact with throughout our day.

The title of my column has only partly to do with my height, but also with how long we have here on Earth, and since we have such a short time here, what are we doing that is bringing us into a deeper relationship with Jesus and a deeper relationship with the people around us, to build up these divine communities? I have believed for a few years now that the best way I deepen my own faith is through the people around me.

I cannot deepen my faith and love of Jesus by myself. I hope and pray that through my column I may open a door for discussion with each of you so that we can grow in our faith together. I am so blessed to begin this new journey of writing and sharing my thoughts with you, and I hope that you will always feel you can share with me as well. I hope that we can form a beautiful community of disciples, a community which is open to growing in our faith together. A community almost as beautiful as the Most Holy Trinity.
