## A VIEW FROM THE SHORT SIDE...

Continuing down the road of sharing moments from Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), I think it's important for you to know that we talk a lot about the Holy Spirit with our 3-6 year old parishioners. We talk about various moments throughout Scripture when the Holy Spirit comes down on people and ways in which the Holy Spirit works. I feel like we all could all talk more about the Holy Spirit - the Holy Spirit is that person of the Trinity who is often an afterthought. The Holy Spirit is a very active member of the Trinity, though, often being the mover and shaker in the world today.

I'd like to share a moment of the Mass that has become very special to me, and I hope it will become very special to you as well; a moment which very much involves the work of the Holy Spirit. This moment is called the Epiclesis. As soon as we kneel down during mass for the Eucharistic Prayers, start looking for this moment. Fr. Bill often uses the following prayer to accompany the Epiclesis, although there are various forms of the prayer:

*"Make holy, therefore, these gifts, we pray, by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall, so that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ."*

The above image is the gesture the priest will use during the Epiclesis. Hopefully between the words I have given you and the gesture you see above, you can find this moment in the Mass.

I've heard these words (or similar words) my whole life. It was not until last summer, when I began the training for CGS, and when the moment of Epiclesis was pointed out to me, that I understood how important this moment is. This is THE moment. This is the moment when the Holy Spirit comes down on our gifts of bread and wine and changes them in the Body and Blood of Christ! This is when it all takes place! And I was gazing off into space, probably day dreaming about what was for lunch that day!



After the Epiclesis is the Consecration, where the priest holds up the Body and Blood and proclaims, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood!" But the Epiclesis is the moment when this miracle takes place! Through the power of the Holy Spirit, God changes our ordinary gifts of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus.

And the amazement continues! This beautiful mystery and miracle...I get to share this with the 3-6 year old members of our parish! And not in some vague way or some watered down version. The children in CGS practice the gesture used during the Epiclesis, they explore the Epiclesis in this profound way, and they ponder the work of the Holy Spirit. When the children are old enough to read, they will also read along with the words the priest will use during the Epiclesis.

I challenge you to watch for this moment. The moment happens so quick that you could miss it if you're not paying attention. But it is a beautiful moment which gives us a glimpse into the power and work of God.

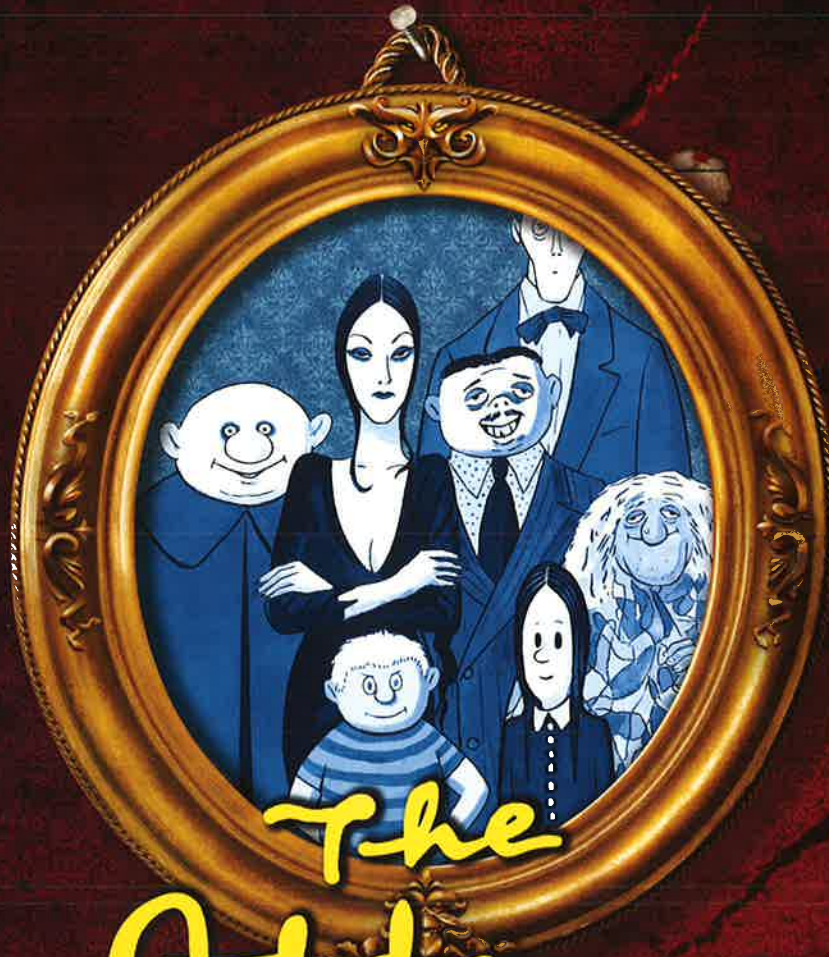
